(High risk per CDC is adults over 65 and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions.) <input type="checkbox"/> Am I under quarantine or stay-at-home order? <input type="checkbox"/> Do I work in close proximity with a person who has been sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 during the past 14 days? <input type="checkbox"/> Do I currently have a fever or any symptoms: cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, muscle or chest pain, fatigue, headache, congestion, runny nose, digestive upset? <input type="checkbox"/> Within the past 14 days, have I been sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 or am I sharing a residence with anyone who has been sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 or tested positive for corona virus? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> FPCB is reopening according to current state and local orders and recommendations. <input type="checkbox"/> The building has been disinfected and cleaned and will be disinfected after use. <input type="checkbox"/> The FPCB reopening team has been trained in social distancing, hygiene practices, health and safety protocols, cleaning and disinfecting. <input type="checkbox"/> FPCB has explained the new operating process for arrivals, seating, worship practices, exits and dealing with apparent illness. <input type="checkbox"/> FPCB has made alternate worship options i.e. On-line streaming available for children, the elderly and the disabled. <input type="checkbox"/> FPCB has made its full reopening plan available. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> FPCB has asked people with symptoms or recent exposure to stay home. <input type="checkbox"/> Everyone coming into FPCB will be required to wear a mask. <input type="checkbox"/> There is an isolation plan for people who become ill while at church. <input type="checkbox"/> Social distancing measures will be clearly marked, explained and enforced. <input type="checkbox"/> FPCB will have masks, tissues and hand sanitizer available for use. <input type="checkbox"/> There will be people to explain, and signs to remind us of new worship practices. <input type="checkbox"/> FPCB is keeping attendance records, and I will be notified if someone tests positive or is diagnosed with COVID-19 who attended a service with me. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> I am willing to stay home if I am ill or may recently have been exposed to COVID-19. <input type="checkbox"/> I am willing to abide by the preventative measures FPCB requires and to record attendance for contact tracing. <input type="checkbox"/> I expect everyone to be wearing a mask. <input type="checkbox"/> I will notify the office before attending a service to be assured of a seat, if necessary. <input type="checkbox"/> I expect social distancing measures to be taken seriously and enforced. <input type="checkbox"/> I expect that I will be contacted in case of possible COVID-19 exposure at church. <input type="checkbox"/> I want to know who to call if I become ill after attending worship service. <input type="checkbox"/> I will let FPCB know if for some reason I am not able to return, after the church has reopened.
