



## What You Need to Know about Returning to FPCB

- ◇ Sunday Worship Service will be held in Mauldin Hall at 9:30 AM.
- ◇ Sanitation—The facility will be fully sanitized prior to worship and after worship.
- ◇ Building Capacity—To maintain six-foot social distancing, we can seat approximately 72 in Mauldin Hall. A 6 x 4 ft box will be taped off to include 4 chairs. Each row is 6 feet from the adjacent row. Families are seated together.
- ◇ Food and drink—will not be available.
- ◇ Sunday School Rooms, CDC, Nursery and Playground are closed.
- ◇ Communion will be prepackaged. Do not feel obligated, if you do not feel comfortable.
- ◇ Hand sanitizer stations will be available.
- ◇ You may be requested to notify the office prior to the service to assure seating. (More details forthcoming.)

## Before Leaving Home

- ◇ Take Your Temperature. Each member of your household should check their temperature before leaving home. If it is more than 100.4°, we request you remain at home and consider contacting your physician.
- ◇ Bring your own mask. Wearing masks is an act of care for one another.
- ◇ Wash your hands.

## Arriving at Church

- ◇ Enter only through door specifically indicated as “ENTER”
- ◇ Doors will open at 9:15 AM. A greeter will open the door for you, sharing a smile, not a handshake. Maintain a 6’ distancing requirement. Attendance will be taken for Contact Tracing purposes. Your temperature will be taken prior to entry.
- ◇ Masks will be required. Place your mask on before you enter. Some may believe a mask is not needed, others feel it is a risk not to wear one. We request everyone wear one. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided for you. Exceptions only for medical reasons and children under age 2. Parental discretion is required, children will remain with parents.
- ◇ One door will be designated for entry the other for exit. Signs and arrows will direct everyone. Ushers will assist.
- ◇ Online and mail-in giving is encouraged. A donation station will be available at the door. No passing of the plate.
- ◇ No use of bulletins or hymnals. Responses and lyrics will be on the screen.
- ◇ Rest Rooms—One single Restroom for Men and One single Restroom for Ladies will be available in the nursery area.
- ◇ End of Service. You will be dismissed by row as announced. Proceed in an orderly manner to the assigned “Exit” door. Please go directly outside maintaining social distancing until you get to your vehicle. We enjoy fellowship with one another, but please do not linger at this time.

## What You Can Do

- ◇ Observe personal hygiene.
  - ◇ Use your elbow to cover coughs.
  - ◇ Wash your hands (for 20 seconds) whenever possible.
  - ◇ Use hand sanitizer as needed. Sanitizer Dispensers are available.
- ◇ Maintain social distancing. In Mauldin Hall you will see signs reminding us to maintain 6-foot distance between households.
- ◇ Please refrain from hugging, shaking hands and close contact. Do not linger as you enter or exit.
- ◇ If you become ill at a service or after attending, you will advise the health care ministry team through the church office.
- ◇ We will continue to Live Stream services.
- ◇ We support those at high risk and stand with those who are not quite ready to attend as yet. We will miss you. You will remain in our loving thoughts and prayers.
